

# Conflict Minerals Policy

INDIUM CORPORATION IS COMMITTED TO A SAFE AND ETHICAL SUPPLY CHAIN.

We take careful measures to ensure that all our materials and supplies are sourced from proper and professional sources and suppliers. We require written assurances, and due diligence, from all our suppliers of pure gold, pure tin, and tin alloys that the sources of their materials are not from "conflict" regions which work in violation of human rights. We also require that all sources of gold, tin, and tin alloys be certified by CSFI.ORG as conflict-free smelters, and that these sources continuously maintain the CFSI.ORG conflict-free certification. Failure to maintain CFSI.ORG conflict-free certification will result in immediate disqualification of that materials source from Indium Corporation's Approved Vendor List (AVL).
